COURSE DESCRIPTION:

AHS 1240 intro to Career Health Occupations

1 Credit

Presents characteristics and skills that are needed in the preparation and employability of persons in the health care setting. Provides an overview of the health care industry, current health care trends/issues, and options for career choices. Discusses the work environment as it relates to health and safety regulations.

AHS 1271 Team Building

1 Credit

Involves the student of team dynamics and communication techniques necessary to promotes effective, collaborative team outcomes. Topics includes: communication, delegated responsibilities, goal setting, coaching, conflict resolution, and roles of the team members.

COA 1215 Intro to Internet

1 Credit

Overview of the development of the Internet. Utilization of the three major components of Internet--electronic file, file transfer protocol, and remote log in (telenet). Overview of UNIX and protocols necessary for the Internet. Exploration of the resources available through the Internet.

COURSE RATIONALE:

METHOD OF INSTRUCTION:

Lecture including guest lecturers, group activities, reading, class discussion, films (videos), field trips, job shadowing, class projects/presentations, quizzes, exams, and skill labs.

ASSESSMENT:

Projects, tests, participation in class, current events/journal, quizzes, worksheets, skills lab, job shadowing, preparation for class.
