**COURSE TITLE:** Spanish III  
**COURSE LENGTH:** Year, Two Credits  
**PREREQUISITE:** Spanish II, "C:" grade or above in Spanish II , or written permission from instructor

**GRADE LEVEL:** 11 or 12

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** Spanish III furthers the study of advanced Spanish grammar and culture. Students will have the opportunity to use Spanish in many tenses and thus discuss most facets of daily life past and present. In addition to text work several short stories and a short novel will be read and discussed. Spain and Mexico will also be studied in depth through legends, articles, games, cooking, music and art.

**COURSE RATIONALE:**

This course further develops reading and writing skills and polishes speaking skills.

**METHOD OF INSTRUCTION:** Multi-faceted teacher, test, tape recordings, workbooks, films, magazines, novels and short stories.

**ASSESSMENT:** Grades will be based on daily work and daily participation both oral and written, oral presentations, oral and written tests, quizzes, reports in Spanish, and group and pair work. Students must pass the first semester of Spanish III with a C- or the permission of the teacher to continue into the second semester of study.

**CRITICAL OBJECTIVES:**

1. to express and understand new ideas in Spanish both orally and written
2. to learn new material in Spanish and discuss the new knowledge in Spanish
3. to refine pronunciation skills
4. to improve reading skills through legends, mysteries and articles
5. to study Spanish and Mexican history and culture in Spanish in articles and legends
6. to participate in conversation relating to daily need or experiences
7. to summarize characters, events, and causes in individual writings
8. narrate events in the past in writing
