

## Sixth Grade Homework Policy

Each school day, the homework/classwork is recorded on a homework sheet by the teachers at our Team meeting time. Copies are made and these copies are available to students who have been absent or need a list of assigned work. The sheets are usually on colored paper and they are placed in folders that are on each end of the sixth grade hall. The sheets are available by noon each school day.

Student work is due at the beginning of each class period and is considered late after that time. Work that is not finished is considered “incomplete” and students are required to complete a late/incomplete slip in class to indicate that they have not met the class requirements for that day.

When work is late, incomplete, or not done, the student will complete a “late slip” indicating that the work is not satisfactorily completed. Every two weeks, the sixth grade team compiles the late slips from all classes. When a student has accumulated two or more slips indicating a failure to complete assigned work in his/her sixth grade classes, a letter, along with these slips, will be sent to parents. It is our hope that parents will assist us in teaching the importance of timely work completion.
